Project #12: Easter Crafts

- Using a rabbit shape, glue cotton onto this.
- For egg shapes, glue various tissue, shapes, sparkles, paint use crayons or marker to decorate.
- Boil some real eggs and be sure they are "hard boiled" (boil up to 15 minutes just to be sure) Place eggs in cool water and place onto stove top. Place lid on the pot. Put on medium to high heat. Watch as they boil. Some may crack open and should just be eaten rather than painted.
- Using Non-toxic Painting kits that can be bought in the Stores, prepare and paint as you like.
- Place in small stands to paint such as a wire frame that usually comes with a kit.
- You can also use the egg carton to place cooked eggs in and paint or a reusable small container such as a fruit cup. This can be done for painting and drying the eggs!
- Colour with Felt pens although this will wash off.
- Colour with crayons before painting and this gives a nice effect.
- Food colouring diluted with water can be used but be careful of the dye in it as it can stain clothing and hands.
- Make Easter Cards by making the Rabbit shape and then placing onto the Fold of paper
 Cut and open up!
