Project #19: Earth Day!

- Take a walk in your neighbourhood. Gather some wild flowers and Dandelions with some going to seed.
- Display the items on a “science table”
- Using some wax paper; place the flowers onto the wax paper.
- Cover this with another piece of wax paper.
- Place in between newspaper with a light cloth on top of all pieces on an ironing surface.
- Iron on top of the cloth to press the wax paper together and seal in the flower arrangement.
- Trim edges in the shape you want; square or rectangle work the best.
- Cover the edges with masking tape to Create a secure Border.
- Place into window for a nice effect.
- Alternatively, you could use Sticky See-through shelf paper. This may be easier for the children as there is no hot iron involved as well as the flowers and seeds will not shift.
