### **Project #22: Puppets**

- Using a paper bag (small for small hands is best) It can be a small lunch bag or flat bag is good for small hands and easier for Toddlers and Preschooler’s to use.
- Cut out eyes, ears, mouth, nose to glue on.
- Using a glue stick, glue these on.
- Draw your own facial features if you like. (more creative)
- Add string, wool, cotton etc. for the fur or hair.
- Another idea is to find a pre-printed animal such as the Dog in the photo attached. Glue onto stronger paper such as construction or cardboard such as from a cereal box. Cut out the entire shape. If children are capable they can cut around the shape without the detailing.
- Add the features as above.
- Attach a popsicle stick or a larger tongue depressor stick to this with tape.
- Use these puppets while singing or doing a puppet show!
