## Project \#26: Colour Wheel

- Cut a circle about 8 inches in diameter out of construction paper or use a paper plate.
- Cut 3 equal "Pie shaped RED, BLUE and YELLOW"
- Glue onto Circle or Plate. To cover the entire circle.
- These are "Primary Colours"
- If children are Preschool age (maybe 4 and up) or a bit older, you can also introduce adding the "Secondary Colours which are Purple, Green and Orange"
- They can be placed in between each series of colours. Red and Blue make Purple, Blue and Yellow make Green. Red and Yellow make orange so try to put them in order.
- Mix paint colours with the children so they may see the changes in the colours and understand which colours make the secondary colours.
- Add Sparkles to your Colour Wheel.
