Project #32: Ladybugs

- Cut out the body shape of ladybug. This can be two circles put together; one big and one small for the head.
- Most ladybugs are red or orange with black spots on them and black legs.
- Cut out 6 legs with a slight bend in them for the leg curve.
- Cut out two straight antennas.
- Wings can be either drawn on with a curve onto to body of the ladybug you cut out or you can make two wings as in the photo below and glue them on with a simple glue stick.
- Cut out some small circles or use plain black circle stickers. Place these onto the wings.
- Attach the legs and antennas with a Glue Stick.
- Add features such as eyes either by drawing with non-toxic felt marker, crayons, sticker eyes or googly eyes.
- Place onto construction paper background and add Trees etc.....

Take a walk outside and see if you can find ladybugs. Look on bushes, trees (especially on the tree trunks). Observe the colours of the ladybugs. They are mostly red or orange but you may find a rare yellow one!
