Project #35: Bees!

- Cut out the body shape of the bee or use two circles and glue small and larger one together. This is Yellow paper.

Cut some thin black curved paper pieces for the stripes.

- Using coffee filters or maybe some waxed paper, cut out wing shapes.
- Make a small triangle shape paper for the “Stinger”!
- Glue all pieces together.
- Trim excess paper off of the Curves.
- Add details such as eyes with drawing or sticker eyes.
- If you like you may glue all pieces onto a white piece of paper. This may be easier for a younger toddler.
- Add scenery.....
