Project # 15: “Brilliant Butterflies”

- Using a Butterfly shape, trace onto various colours of construction paper.
- Make a small slim oval type body.
- Cut both Butterfly and body shapes out.
- Use Pipe Cleaners or paper slips for the Antennas.
- Glue all pieces onto another sheet of construction paper.
- Add shapes for wings, eyes, and draw your own colours with Non-toxic felt pens or crayons. Use the Scraps of the left over Construction paper for the shapes so as not to waste the paper.
- Googly eyes can be used for Preschoolers but maybe sticker eyes for toddlers for safety. Drawing your own eyes is best for creativity though!
- Add Sparkles if you have them; either the liquid sparkles or using a glue stick can glue shaker types sparkles.
- Make a large butterfly shape and place on easel for painting.
- Take a walk and see if you can notice any butterflies yet. Look for Caterpillars.
