Project # 16: Caterpillars

- Cut some round circles of various colours out of construction paper. Cut short strips of paper for legs and antennas.
- Glue them together with a simple Glue Stick creating a long or short caterpillar.
- Attach legs and antennas with the glue stick.
- Using Non-Toxic Felt Markers or crayons colour them, put dots on them, glue tissue paper or whatever you can think of to decorate them with colours.
- Add eye by either drawing them or using sticker eyes for Toddlers or Googly eyes for children that are Preschool age.
- Another idea is to use a wooden stick such as a Popsicle Stick or something a bit larger like a Tongue depressor size.
- Glue some Colourful Pom Poms onto the Stick.
- Add Sticker Eyes
- Add a short Pipe Cleaner for the Antennas.

Read the Story: “The Very Hungry Caterpillar”. This can be by the book or a Felt Story. The children can participate if it is a Felt Story as they can bring the Pieces up to the Felt Board taking turns and being involved!

Take a walk and see if you may see Caterpillars or Cocoons!

Watch for Butterflies and Moths as well!
