Project #18: Kites

- Cut out the kite shape from Construction Paper. Simply fold the paper in half lengthwise and cut two triangle shaped pieces off each side (not on the fold). Open up and check the Kite shape! Make your own shape!
- Next place a small piece of Scotch Tape or Sticker paper onto the top and the bottom of the Kite.
- Using a Hole puncher, punch one hole in both ends into the secured Tape/Sticker paper area. This will be strong for the String to go through.
- Using a ruler, draw the Kite lines, one across and one down as in photo. This represents the “poles” in the kite.
- Children can then draw, glue and place stickers on the kite.
- Have children then help with the threading of the lightweight package wrapping “String” for the top handle and the bottom Streamers.
- Also Streamers can be Crepe paper cut into lengthwise Strips.
- Go outside and run with your kite! Can be used indoors as well.
- Pick a windy day!
