### **Project #24: Baby Animals: Collage**

- Gather magazines and calendars that are Wild Life animals and birds.
- Cut out the pictures.
- For children it is easier for you to take the entire page out and also cut it in to smaller pieces for the children to handle them easier.
- Younger children and toddlers can practice snipping scraps of paper.
- Glue the picture/s onto another base paper.
- Add in any details you want; could be grass, trees, clouds, sun, rain, people or anything you can think of.
- Add natural items such as seeds, grass, wood chips.....
- Be creative; let the children decide how the pieces go onto to paper.
- There are no rules as this is free art. The photos DO NOT have to be perfect. The abilities, capabilities and ideas are the child’s process.
- It is “THE PROCESS NOT THE PRODUCT”. There is no right or wrong.
