### Project #25: Colour Collage

- Cut out various shapes out of coloured paper. Can be construction paper as it is strong. Make triangles, squares, rectangles, circles, ovals and diamonds. Make other shapes. Learn the shapes.
- Glue these onto another piece of construction paper.
- Add some tissue paper, can be cut or ripped into various shapes.
- Scrunch the tissue paper into balls and glue them on.
- Glue various colours of cellophane paper.
- Add some felt marker or crayon design to your collage.
- Glue on some sparkles.
- Use glitter glue.
- Create houses or buildings with the shapes. Add in scenery. Draw.

Be creative and just let the children explore and make their own design.
