Project #33: Spiders!

- Cut out the black body shape as shown below or cut out two circles, one small for the head and one big for the body (attached together with a glue stick).
- It may be best to glue the body onto some paper to secure it in place.
- Cut out 8 legs with a bend in them as shown. (Spiders have eight legs)
- Glue legs on to spider.
- Add eyes with either sticker eyes, googly eyes or a white marker or white crayon.
- Add some white spots that may represent the texture of the spider.
- If you are making one that is not placed onto the paper, you may want to use a hole punch and attach a String to hang the spider!
- If the spider is on the paper, you may want to make a Spider Web by drawing it onto the paper around the Spider!
- Another idea would be to draw nature around the spider such as trees, bushes, grass etc. Maybe a Barn...

Go for a walk, look for Spiders. Do not touch them or pick them up as they can bite. Look for Spider webs. You may see them attached to the low bushes or railings or even on your patio!
