### Project #36 Bee Hives!

- Using some brown construction paper, cut out Bee Hive Shapes.
- Cut out yellow shapes as shown below.
- Use some natural nature items as the tree seeds below.
- Use a glue stick or white liquid glue for texture.
- Add details with non-toxic markers or crayons. Draw in some bee shapes.
- Glue the yellow pieces as well as the tree seeds or other natural nature items that you may find suitable for texture for the bee hive.

Activity: Take a walk.

Notice the spring flowers and you may see bees in the flowers. Bees make honey. Buy some honey in your local store for the children to try, liquid and pasturized. Be safety conscious and explain to children we just look and not touch. Bees Stings can be serious and also hurt.
