- Use various sizes so they will fit together in proportion.
- Try to blend the colours in proportion such as the red, orange, yellow and the green, blue and purple to form a pattern for the rainbow.

- Add raindrops by drawing or cutting small droplets.
- Draw birds in the air, trees, flowers and other nature items.
- Draw Lightning Bolts for a Thunder Storm!
- Add sparkles; the children love painting with liquid sparkles!
