Project #40: Fish Aquarium

- Materials paper 2 paper plates, paper fish shapes, tissue paper, non-toxic felt markers or crayon, bubble paper (optional) Stapler or secure tape.
- Cut the circular center out of one of the paper plates.
- The other paper plate can be decorated with fish, tissue paper for seaweed, bubble paper for the water and various felts and crayons can be drawn onto the Aquarium you are creating! Be flexible; there are many different ideas so leave this as a very open project. The children can create their own design.
- Scraps of paper may also be used for seaweed.
- If you have some sand or light small shells, these can also be attached using some liquid white Non-toxic glue.
- Attach the paper plates together with Staples or Tape; add a String!

Take a walk on the beach or the riverside. Look in the sand and in the water. What do you see?
