Project #42: Paper Plate Turtles

- **Materials:** paper plates, precut head shape, 4 feet shapes and one tail shape. Attached the legs, head and tail to the paper plate in a turtle shape. This can be done by staples, tape or glue.
- If using glue or a glue stick, allow it to dry for a few minutes.
- Draw and colour onto the turtle body. Attached or draw eyes.
- Use a hole puncher and string to hang the turtle if you like.
- Use paint on the turtle.
- Maybe try Bingo Dabbers as this makes a nice pattern on the Turtle.

Actions: Do a Turtle Walk. Do Turtles walk slow or fast?

Talk about various turtles as some very large Tortoise are very strong and also can be use as Guards for a yard.
