Project #55: Wild Roses! Wild Poppies!

- Gather some wild rose and poppy petals from the ground. (at River Front)
- Lay them flat and press in between 2 sheets of newspaper, covered by a heavy book overnight. This will help flatten them for sticking to paper.
- Make some paper shaped petals as well.
- Make some leaf shapes and stems. They do not have to be perfect and children can help with this type of cutting and drawing as well.
- Make a design on your paper using the natural and paper petals and leaves using a glue stick.
- Add detailing of the leaves and petals with markers or crayons.
- Add some natural cotton that you may also find at the River Front.
- Alternatively, you can also use Sticky Shelving paper to arrange your design. The petals and pieces will stick automatically. Cotton pieces and seeds from the cotton plant will also easily stick.
