Project #58: Owls!

- Using Cardboard or another strong paper, cut out the body shape of the Owl
- Next find some animal print type cloth with texture is best like a velour type.
- Cut out the shape of the body and the wings of the owl.
- Using white non-toxic liquid glue, glue the cloth body onto the cardboard shape leaving the wings free of glue.
- Add some eyes either by drawing or using sticker eyes or Googly eyes.
- When all is dry, add any other details you like with non-toxic felt pens.
- Place the owl in an indoor planter, hang it by a string, play with it, make a tree for it etc
