Project #65: Driftwood Beach Creations!

- Gather some Drift wood, shells, seaweed, sand, and maybe some feathers (Wash Feathers and be careful to check for insects)
- Using non-toxic white liquid glue, pour a generous amount onto the Driftwood.
- Add shells, let Dry thoroughly.
- When Dry, add some of the lighter weight items to your creation using the white glue. A little less glue is needed for the lighter items.
- Let Dry thoroughly.
- Squirt a little more glue in some areas and sprinkle some sand onto the Driftwood for a beachy look.
- Display on your patio, on a window sill, on a “Science” Table
- Science Table could have other items as well such as beach rocks, various types of Seaweed.
- Add some pre-bought Clean sand to your Science area so the children can play with it, scoop it, pour it etc.

Outing: Go to the Beach to gather these items first so it becomes your own!
