Project #66: Beach Collage

- Cut out various pictures from newspaper flyers, catalogues or magazines.
- Let the children be creative and use the scissor if capable. Pictures do not have to be perfect.
- Have the children arrange and glue them onto some construction paper of a colour of their choice.
- A glue stick works efficiently for this.
- Add in some drawing details.
- Encourage creativity by asking what they think could be at the beach, what kind of shoes and clothing do you wear to the Beach.
- Talk about Sunscreen.
- Add the Sun to your Beach Collage.
- Add puffy clouds (cumulous clouds)
- What kind of birds could be at the beach? Draw some.
- Simple shapes like an “m” can also look like a bird.
