Project #72: River Birds!

- Cut out various shapes to create the “River Birds”.
- Use some soft velour type fabric to glue onto the bird shapes.
- Look at the colours and lines of the birds in the photo below and see if you can imagine how to create these birds. Use beads for the eyes.
- Try creating the birds out of clay and let dry.
- Paint the birds when dry.
- Add details like the eyes and the beak.
- Use playdough to create the Birds.
- Playdough can be baked on a cookie sheet at a low temperature in the oven to dry it out.
- Paint them add fabric, wool etc. Add feathers!

Activity: Go for a River Walk. Close your eyes and listen to the birds. Go on a Bird Watching Walk. See if you can find the birds that make the sounds. They Grey and White one in the below photo you will often hear at the River and outlying areas.

Chant: Two little Birds
