Project #76: Remembrance Day Poppies

- Form a Poppy Shape out of Red Construction Paper.
- Add some details for the lines of the poppy with felts or crayons.
- Cut some small circles out of Black Construction Paper.
- Using a glue stick, glue the black circle into the center of the poppy.
- Add details to the Poppy but adding some crumpled tissue paper for a 3D look. This looks nice and more “natural” for the Poppy.
- Another idea is to cut a circle out of a paper plate. Then decorate that with small poppies around the edges.
- Also you could use the paper plate as the base for the poppy and add details to it with the black center and the tissue paper, pens and crayons. Or try painting it!

Ideas for songs or stories could be based on caring, respecting and honouring each other as well as the people who fought in the wars.
