## **Project #73: Fall Leaves:**

- Gather colorful Fall Leaves Outdoors on a Nature Walk.
- Press leaves in between heavy books or magazines overnight to flatten.
- Place colourful leaves onto some see-through sticky shelf paper. Cover with some seethrough waxed paper.
- Make a colourful border around this using some various colours of construction paper or masking tape works well. These can be stapled on or you may use clear scotch tape for a nice finish. (this may be best for younger children and Toddlers as it is safer for them rather than staples.
- Variations may be adding some tree seeds, adding paper bits, tissue paper flower petals or other natural items you may think of.
- The borders can be coloured with felt pens with some detailing or just bursts of colour.

## Activities: Jump into the leaves, swish leaves around with your feet, throw the leaves to make them fly! Enjoy nature!
