Project #90: Christmas Stockings

- Cut out Stocking shapes from poster board. Wall Paper is great to use.
- Using a hole puncher, punch holes onto the edges.
- Cut some ribbon or string to a suitable length for weaving it through the hole. Secure both ends with knots.
- Shoelaces can also be used as they have a great tip for weaving in and out to the holes.
- Insert and tie the ribbon, string or laces onto one end of the stocking.
- Create a pattern of weaving in and out the holes. It could be an overcast or it could be like weaving in and out. Be creative and do what you like. Try not to over guide the children but also give some direction on a pattern and assist them in guiding the string and ribbon through the holes.
- When done, tie the ends into a knot. You should have enough string or ribbon left over at the top to create a loop to hang the Stocking!
 Add some stickers, drawings, sparkles etc. to your creation!

<u>Activity:</u> Use socks or stockings as puppets. Place on hands and pretend to talk.

Make a puppet show with them. Add some buttons for eyes, wool for hair Be creative with them.
