- Cut out a Polar Bear Tracer from Cardboard. (can find them on a calendar or online)
- Have the children trace the polar bear.
- Older children can trace and maybe cut the Bear shape out.
- For younger children and toddlers, prepare the bear shape out of construction paper.
- Children can then glue on wool, cotton, string or white tissue paper.
- Another idea is white paint.
- Add some details such as drawing the eyes, sticker eyes, (googly eyes for older children as they can be a choking hazard)
- Try using white chalk on the construction paper. It blends nicely.
- Glue some smaller bears onto a poster board and create the Bear Family. Add Trees, mountains, oceans, ice, fish for the bears food.
