Project #13 – Shakers!

- Gather some paper towel tubes and cut into 3 equal sections. (*do not use* <u>Toilet paper Rolls as they are not hygienic</u>)
- Securely Staple one end closed (3 staples should work) or alternatively use very strong tape such a Duct Tape.
- Place something inside such as out dated macaroni pieces, rice or something that will make a sound. Be careful when choosing as things may be a choking hazard for young children.
- After placing the "Noisy item" into the tube press the other side closed but do so in the opposite fashion so the tube becomes a shape as shown in the Photo Below.
- Using a simple Glue Stick, glue tissue paper onto the shaker. Layer it as much as you like and you will see the blending of the colours as well.
- Colour it with non-toxic Felt pens is another idea.
- Have fun and "SHAKE IT" to music, to songs, for exercise and anything else you can think of.
