Project #39: Fish Collage

- Cut out various, shapes of fish.
- Find magazine photos of fish and cut out. Let the Preschool Child help with cutting and choosing. Give the children smaller pieces of paper to cut so they may manipulate it easier. And small blunt scissors.
- On a blank piece of paper, glue the various fish onto it. You may want to start with some scenery on the paper such as a lake, river, ocean and some land around this. Add details to the fish with markers or crayons.
- Add some texture to the collage such as tissue paper seaweed. Or seaweed cut out of coloured paper.
- Add some sand by gluing it on (you can buy some or simply collect it from the beach)
- Add some small light weight shells to the beach area of your collage and maybe some in the water too.

Outing: Take a walk to the beach, river front or lake. Sit and watch as you may see some jumping fish. If you are on a pier, watch the water closely as you may see a “School Of Fish”

Song: “Have you ever Gone a Fishin” (can use this as a chant or choose a tune)
