Project #41: Spool Stamping Fish

- **Materials:** Liquid non-toxic paint, reusable plastic trays, paper towels, spools from thread or other small stamping type objects (washable) Construction Paper, Sticker Eyes (Optional) Hole puncher String.
- **Cut out large fish shapes of various kinds from the Construction paper.** Children can cut their own if they are capable. It doesn't have to be perfect and leave it open-ended. There are no rules and children can be creative on shape of fish and style of stamping.
- **Draw eyes onto the fish or use sticker eyes; drawing is better for creativity and fine motor control.**
- **Place paper towel into the washable plastic tray.**
- **Spread liquid paint over the paper towels and let soak in for awhile.**
- **Children can use the “Spools” for stamping the prints onto the fish after they have drawn whatever they like onto the fish.**
- **Let Dry; use a hole punch and a String if you would like to hang them up.**
