- Use the seeds that you find as well.

- Add your own details such as scenery etc. by drawing and colouring
- Add some Pine cone pieces that you can also find under the trees in various areas. You may need liquid white glue for these textured pieces. (pull the cone apart)
- Add some sand to your work of Art! (river sand!)
