Project #56: Dragonflies

- Prepare shapes from construction paper for the body of the dragonfly.
- Make some wings from either more construction paper or possibly use some wax paper, tissue paper or anything else that seems like it would make good wings
- Glue the wings onto the body.
- Decorate with details.
- Add some sparkles for fun, glitter glue or glue on sparkles.
- Googly eyes or sticker eyes are an option. (Googly eyes only for older children around 4 plus as they can be a choking item)
- Glue your dragonfly onto a paper and create scenery around it.
- Turn it into a mobile with a string attached so you can fly it.

Take a walk outside and look at nature. You may see a dragonfly. They like water areas so maybe find them at the river front?
