Project #43: Frogs!

- Materials: Green and/or brown construction paper, Glue Stick, non-toxic felt pens, crayons, bingo dabbers (optional), Sticker eyes (optional).
 Textured paper or tissue paper, Small circular paper make nice spots for the frogs.
- Trace and cut out a Frog shape.
- Add details with the above materials.
- Be creative, there are no rules.
- Adding some textured paper can give the frog the bumpy feel.
- Place frog/frogs onto another piece of paper and create a "Pond" for the frog/s.
- Add details like lily pads, waves, greenery etc.
