Project #78: Fall Leaves

- Cut out various leaf shapes out of Colourful Construction paper. Choose maple, oak, and other shapes of leaves.
- Make large ones and smaller ones out of the Scraps of Construction paper.
- Use the odds and ends of shapes that are left over as well.
- All shapes and smaller leaves can be glued onto the large leaf with a glue stick.
- Add crumpled tissue paper for a 3D look.
- Paint the leaf.
- Use Bingo dabbers, felt pens and crayons to draw on the leaf. It is good to draw some lines (veins) on the leaf before decorating it.
- With some of the smaller leaves, create a collage on a piece of Blue or Green construction paper. Add some scenery like the sun, grass, other trees, hills etc.

Activity: Go for a walk and notice the Fall changes. Leaves are falling. Tree may be bare. Some trees such as evergreens never lose their leaves..... Other trees do.
