### Project #101 Jelly Fish

- Cut the Jelly Fish shape.
- Cut some thin strips of paper.
- Prepare some liquid paint in small cups to use with small paint brushes or Q Tips.
- Have some paper sticky eyes (can be bought as stickers or you can buy a roll of sticky eyes) Googly eyes are an option but not recommended for toddlers.
- Have some felt markers or crayons available.
- Using a glue stick, glue all parts together as shown in attached pictures.
- Some Bubble paper may also be nice for this to glue onto the Jelly Fish for a texture and 3D effect.
