## **Project #102: Spots for Gerry Giraffe!**

- Cut out a Giraffe Body shape and the neck/head shape from construction paper.
- Cut out various shapes for the Spots!
- The spots can be natural shapes like leaves, also standard shapes like circles, squares etc. (for learning shapes)
- Use various colours for learning colours.
- Glue all body and head/neck together, add the "Spots" to various areas of the Giraffe. You may also choose to place this onto another piece of construction paper to make it easier for the children/toddlers to do.
- Add details to your giraffe such as the eyes, nose, mouth.
- Add some yarn for the tail and mane is another idea.
- Add a tree to your picture as Giraffes eat leaves from tall trees.

## Felt Story: Create Gerry Giraffe from felt pieces

- Gerry Giraffe was looking around for his Spots!
- While he was walking along, he found a Leaf shape spot! (put it on the Giraffe or children can also help with this)
- Continue this until all the spots are on Gerry Giraffe. (make comments about the shapes and colours)
