### Project #94 Snowflakes

- Cut some strips of Dark and Light Blue Construction Paper
- Using at least 4 Strips, Criss Cross then and glue them in middle with a glue stick.
- Using a Q Tip, dab some white liquid paint onto the snowflake.
- Add some sparkles if you like.
- Make a snow scene on a large poster board using the snowflakes.
- Another idea is to make a mobile with them. Hang them onto a stick or a coat hanger.
- Place them in a semi-breezy area and watch them sway around.

#### Activity:

Go for a walk on a snowy day. Catch the snowflakes in your hands. Lay on your back and move arms back and forth to make a snow angel.
