Project #96: Toques

- Cut out some toque shaped construction paper.
- Cut out some pom pom shapes out of various colours and types of paper.
- Have some cotton balls and/or pom poms to glue on.
- Add some wool pieces.
- Provide some paint on some paper towels to dab shapes onto the toque.
- Maybe place some cotton striping on the edge of the toque. (for the cotton balls, please stretch the cotton as it is very easy to spread it out, easier to glue on and saves on waste of materials.
- Add some fabric pieces.....
- Sparkle glue is nice too.

Activity:

Go for a walk with your toque on. Notice others with toques. What colours do you see? Take the toque off and on and feel the difference in temperature. Build a snowman and place a toque on the snowman. Read snow stories as almost all of them will have people wearing hats or toques. Make a felt story with various colours of the hats or toques.
