- Out of Poster Board, cut various large shapes such as Circles, Rectangles and Squares.
- Have children choose the shape they like.
- Using Blue and White liquid children's paint cover the paper with the paint.
- You can use large paint brushes, dabbing with cotton balls attached to a clothespin, stamping tools and even some small Q Tips for details.
- Add some liquid glue.
- Sprinkle on some salt for a snow effect.
- Attach Cotton balls. Spread the cotton balls apart by pulling as this makes a nice effect and this also reduces the amount of waste of materials.
- Sparkles could be a nice touch.
- Make some smaller shapes and add to a "Mobile" with string attached to a stick or a plastic hanger. Sparkles would look nice on these as it will shine as it blows under some light.

Activity:

Place some ice or snow into a see-through jar or bowl. Add some salt. What happens? Add some food colouring. What happens? Add various food colouring. What happens? (blue and yellow make green!)
