Project #106 Chameleon

- Cut out a Chameleon Shape. Make them large and small sizes.
- Place the shape onto the covered table.
- Using poster paints with water and brushes, gently paint the chameleon various colors. Use large and small brushes. Change water regularly.
- Look for a photo of the real Chameleon to compare it.
- Add some coloured sand for a texture as chameleons have rough scales and skin. Think of other textures you may like to use.
- Using white glue and on a stronger cardboard shape of the Chameleon, you may be able to add some broken shells for example.
- Add some eyes by drawing, painting or gluing.
- Place you painting in a light changing situation and watch the Chameleon change colours.
- Add some tinted paper or tissue paper to your chameleon!

Activity:

- Use a coloured see-through paddle to view the chameleon.
- View the chameleon through a binocular and add some tinted paper at the end of the binocular.
