Project #121 Bean Bag Toss

- Using some Foam squares as shown in photo below, line them up in a row.
 CoUse any colour you like, or you can refer to the primary colours: Red,
 Yellow, Green. Or another example is below such as the "Traffic Light" colours. Talk about the meaning behind the colours for Traffic lights.
- Add a pan or container at the end of the row of squares.
- Using a bean bag, aim and throw at the intended square to land on.
- You could use a point system where green is one, yellow is two points, red is three points, and the bucket is Four Points!
- For younger children and toddlers, no points at all, just have fun tossing the bean bag. Try to aim for a colour.
- This a great activity for fun as well as gross and fine motor control.
- Aim at the "Colour" and the toddlers and children can learn their colours!

<u>Art Activity:</u> Using sing various shapes of coloured paper, create a collage! Create a house, buildings, etc.

Music and Movement:

There are Bean Bag songs with movement actions that you may find online:

Example: (Chant)

Throw the bean bag way up, Turn around, Turn around, Stomp, stomp, stomp Put it on your shoulder and walk around the room, walk, walk, walk.

Repeat with various movements; get input/ideas from the children.
