Project #124: Rock Painting

- Gather some medium sized rocks that are suitable for painting.
- Using Acrylic paint, an Adult can paint the rocks and let them dry.
- Try white paint but other colours can make the rocks look great too.
- When the rocks are dry, children can paint them with non-toxic liquid paint.
- Washable felt markers are another way of colouring the rocks.
- Try using Non-toxic Liquid White Glue and attach some fabric, string, tissue paper, wool etc. The Liquid glue is needed for most fabric type material.
- Add some googly eyes with the white glue or you can use sticker eyes.
- Try placing your decorated rocks or "Pet Rocks" into the garden, yard or patio.
- Try painting with various brushes or natural items such as the pussy willow in the photo shown below.

Activity:

Go for a walk and view various types of rocks. Go on a rock hunt and you may see various other decorated rocks around parks and in gardens.

Go to a Garden Center and you may find some rock formations and possibly terrariums made with some rocks.
