Project #125: Bee Hives

- Create a Beehive Shape as shown below out of light brown construction paper.
- Draw the Beehive lines on it with a felt marker using a curved angle to give it a sense of depth and circular shape.
- On some packaging "Bubble Paper" have the children paint the bubble paper with Yellow liquid paint.
- After they have explored the painting, allow the children to make a "Print" onto the lined side of the Beehive shape.
- Add a small black circle of construction paper to imitate the opening of the beehive.
- Create some small bees to glue onto this when the hive is dry.

Activity:

Go for a walk and observe the flowers. You may see bees on the flowers. Talk about safety around bees as they can sting so no touching the flower or the bee that is on it.

Go to the store and buy a jar of Honey (liquid clear honey) Taste it, spread it onto bread, put it in some tea etc.

Song: "Hickety Tickety Bumble Bee"

Hickety Tickety Bumble Bee can you say your name for me?

(Sarah, Sarah) and that's a very nice name!

Repeat for each child taking turns with each person's name.
