Project #126: Easter Bags (Project by Kid's Care Preschool)

- Take a "Lunch Style Paper Bag" of any colour.
- Cut out some rabbit ear shapes, whiskers, nose and mouth shape.
- Glue these onto the paper bags as shown or let the children be creative with them. They may choose to make a Beard with the Whiskers and that is okay!
- Add some googly eyes or sticker eyes for the younger toddlers
- You may want to draw the eyes on too.
- On the back of your bag add a little fluff tail of cotton.
- White non-toxic children's glue is good for this project.
- When dry, these bags can be used for an "Egg Hunt" or they can also be use for the Easter Morning Treats that the "Easter Bunny" puts in them.
