Project #128 Easter Eggs

- Hard Boil some eggs or buy some white packaged plastic eggs from the Dollar Store.
- Have children draw on these with some crayons.
- Mix some food colouring with water to create the "Dip" for painting the eggs.
- Use a medium sized spoon for the children to gently dip their eggs into the coloured water. Use a paint shirt to protect clothing!
- Try dipping it into various colours and watch the egg change colour. Such as yellow first and then some blue and it should turn green for example.
- When you are done with the crayons and the coloured water, place the egg into the egg carton to dry.
- Later you may want to draw some more onto your egg with non-toxic felt markers.
- Maybe add some stickers.
- If you use real boiled eggs, they can be eaten after if the egg has only been dipped into the food colouring and water.
- To be safe, do not create germs by sharing the water. Each child should have their own individual food colouring water.

Activity: Egg Hunt

Do a plastic Easter Egg Hunt. Plastic coloured eggs can be bought in most grocery store or Dollar Stores. If you like, please place just one wrapped chocolate egg into the plastic eggs.
