Project #130 Paper Easter Eggs

- Cut an Egg shape our of construction paper. Use various colours.
- Use the scrap paper from the trimmings to create triangles, strips of paper or other shapes. This is a great "Snipping" project for the children to create their own shapes.
- Children can use felts, crayons, pencil crayons etc. to make designs on their egg shape. It is totally creative so does not have to be even or perfect.
- Use a glue stick to add on bits of paper or shapes.
- Add some stickers.
- Try using some bingo dabbers, paint, or sparkles.
- Think about making a mobile of smaller eggs to hang by a string onto a hanger..... or wooden spoon......

Activity:

Go on an Egg Hunt. Hide your paper eggs or plastic eggs. See how many you can find. Talk about the colours of the eggs. If you use plastic eggs, you could possibly put some stickers inside the eggs. Store bought plastic eggs may have some with sticker or tattoos. Makes a healthier Egg Hunt instead of Candy in the eggs
