Project #142: Earth Day

- Cut out some round circles of Smooth type paper.
- Place into a tray.
- Prepare some small containers of food colouring mixed with some water.
- Pour some liquid "Corn Syrup" onto the smooth paper circle.
- The children can then take a "Plastic Paste Stick" or a popsicle stick and spread the corn syrup around. They may want to "Taste" it along the way.
- After they are done spreading it and maybe tasting it, take an "Eye Dropper" of various colours of the food colour/water solution to drop bits of colour onto the paper. Be careful of food colouring as it does stain!
- Children can then spread the colours around with the stick that they have!
- Talk about how the colours blend and change such as "red and yellow make orange" "Blue and yellow make green" "red and blue make purple" Etc.
- Let dry and hang up on wall. If you make various sizes of "Planets" they could also be strung as a "Mobile" by hanging them from a stick or hanger to be placed on a doorknob, ceiling, or other ideas of where to hang them...
