Project #133: Spring Flowers

- Make some tracers of a flower shape and the leaf/stem shape. These can be made out of light cardboard such as a Cereal box or medium weight cardboard.
- Preschool age children may be able to trace around this to form their own flower to colour. The tracings can be stem and flower on top.
- Another variation can be to provide the children with the cut out the Stem and Flower Shape out of construction paper.
- They can glue this together as one piece or onto another piece of paper.
- All flowers can have tissue paper added for detailing.
- Maybe add some paint, sparkles or other suitable details you may think of.
- An Idea would be to get the "Dandelion" flower seeds and glue them on with a glue stick.
- Cut out flower petals, stems and leaves and put them together as a garden on a piece of Construction Paper.
- Add the sun, wind, rain, grass, trees etc.
