Project #134: Spring Trees

- Cut out the tree trunk shape from some brown construction paper.
- Cut out some leaf shapes.
- Rip tissue paper into small pieces.
- Place all parts onto a piece of construction paper to form you own type of tree. Add tissue paper.
- Another idea is to trace your child's hand.
- The hand shape can be the tree trunk.
- Add some paper leaves and tissue paper blossoms.
- Paint the hand shape and then add details....
- Use a printed Tree shape and add details with crayons or felt marker,
- Create a scenery picture of various trees and gardens.
- Add some mountains.

Activity: Go for a Springtime Walk.

This is a wonderful time to take walk and notice the Blossoms on the Trees. Also the new leaf buds on the trees. Note the difference in the trees and leaves. Evergreen trees are different than Deciduous Trees.....
