Project #135: Airplanes

- Cut out some large paper airplane shapes.
- Cut out some extra wing pieces and some square and rectangles for doors and windows.
- Take some cotton balls and clothespins to pinch them for painting the sky onto some blue or white construction paper.
- Dab the paper with blue or white paint to create the background sky for your airplane. You may also want to add small wispy pieces of cotton to the painting to create a 3D look for the clouds.
- Next Create your airplane by gluing the wings onto the plane as well as doors and windows.
- Draw some people onto your airplane maybe in the windows.
- Add some detailing to your plane by using some tin foil or sparkles for the lights.
- When your painted paper is dry, add the airplane to your "Sky"

Activity:

Go for a walk and notice the airplanes in the sky.

Take a drive to the airport area to view the airplanes on the ground.

Read books on airplanes.
