Project #136: Traffic Lights

- Cut out a rectangle in black construction paper.
- Draw 3 circles onto this with White Pencil.
- Cut out bits of green, orange, and red paper.
- Glue this paper onto your circles in order from red, orange, and green to create the traffic lights.
- Add some sparkle to the lights to create an illuminated look.
- Next you may like to form two "Sliders" out of more construction paper to cover the lights you want to.
- Slide them up and down depending on which light you wish to use.
- Alternatively, you may want to cut out the red, orange, and green circles and glue them in place. Sparkles can be placed onto these as well.
- Add a popsicle stick to the end to hold it up.

Chant:

Red, Light, Red light What do you Say.

I Say Stop and Stop right away.

Orange light, Orange light, what do you say.

I say wait till the light turns green.

Green light, green light, what do you mean,

I say go, first look each way.

Thank you, thank you, red, orange and green.

Now we know what the traffic lights mean.
