Project #138: Boats

- Cut some triangles out of various colours and patterns of paper.
- On a blue piece of construction paper, you may draw some wavy lines for the water.
- Using a toothbrush or paint brush, paint over these lines with white paint mixed with some white non-toxic liquid glue to give it a nice natural and somewhat textured look.
- Take your triangle shapes and fold one size on an angle as shown in the photos below.
- Place these onto you painted paper. If the paper is still wet, it works well. If the painted paper is dry, you could also use a glue stick to attach the "Boats" to the "Water" paper.
- After it is all dry, you could add some other details such as ducks, fish, frogs or other sea creatures in the water.
- Cotton could be used for some texture in the waves.
- Add some people to your boats by drawing them.
- Stickers could be used but it is more create if children that are capable of drawing details should use their creativity.
